

The winners will be publicised around the world, featured in an exhibition in Paris, and published in the P×3 Annual Book!

P×3 Photographer of the Year—\$5,000 cash prize

Professional photographers compete for the top award–the title of "P×3 Photographer of the Year" and \$5,000 cash prize. The Photographer of the Year is chosen from among the 1st prize winners in each of the 6 Pro Categories. 
